Do you need legal help to get care for a sick child?

Children who live in poverty are exposed to serious health risks at a higher rate. We can provide legal help to get appropriate care for a child who is sick or injured.

Hartford children are at risk.

Hartford has the second highest child poverty rate in the nation. Children need access to health care. Poverty and language or cultural barriers sometimes put children at greater risk.

Are you eligible for MLPP help?

The MLPP represents low-income families, and there is no charge for its services. You can be referred by your affiliated pediatric or family medicine provider.
