How do I know if my child can get free tutoring?

If your child qualifies for free tutoring, your school district should let you know at the beginning of the school year. If you want to find out if your child qualifies, you can contact the school principal, parent coordinator, or the school district's NCLB contact. Telephone numbers are listed on the back of this brochure.

How old does my child have to be to qualify?

School age children in any grade may qualify.

Who provides the tutoring?

- Public schools
- Private tutors
- Community services (like a Boys or Girls Club)
- Faith based organizations (church, mosque, temple)

How can I sign my child up?

At the beginning of the school year, the school should give you a registration form to fill out. It will tell you when to hand the form in, and who to give it to.

What subjects can my child get tutoring in?

That depends on the provider. The registration form will have this information.

Where is the tutoring provided?

- Schools
- Community organizations
- In your home

The registration form will tell you where each agency provides tutoring.

When is the tutoring provided?

- Before or after school
- Weekends
- Summer vacation

Can children in Special Education qualify?

Yes.

Can children who do not speak English or are in a bilingual program qualify?

Yes.
